**APPROVED 2004 CANADIAN NATIONAL TIMETABLE**

- September 2003** Distribution and Internet posting of Jessup Compromis and Official Rules by ILSA.
- October 2003** Distribution of Basic Materials by ILSA (a diskette of basic research materials, designed to ensure that all teams, regardless of budget and access to information, start from the same position). Teams should submit requests for documents for the second diskette (distributed in December) by December 1, 2003.
- Distribution and Internet posting of Canadian National Division Rules Supplement in English and French by the Canadian National Administrator.
- October 15, 2003** **DEADLINE for Canadian National Division Team Registration** - Team registration form and \$1000 registration fee must be forwarded to the Canadian National Administrator. *See Supplemental Rule 3(a).*
- November 7, 2003** **DEADLINE for Requests for Clarifications** - Requests must be made to the ILSA Executive Office via mail, fax, or email. *See Official Rule 7.0.*
- November 18, 2003** Clarifications posted on the ILSA website at [www.ilsa.org](http://www.ilsa.org). The Canadian National Administrator will distribute and post the Clarifications in English and French on the Canadian Qualifying Tournament web page at <http://faculty.law.ubc.ca/jessup> as soon as possible after ILSA posts the Clarifications.
- November 24, 2003** **DEADLINE for Non-U.S. Team Registration with ILSA** - Team registration form and fee must be forwarded to the ILSA Executive Office. *See Official Rule 3.1.*
- DEADLINE for Canadian National Division Individual Participant Registration** – Individual participant registration form must be forwarded to the Canadian National Administrator. Withdrawal from the competition after this date will result in forfeiture of the National Division registration fee. *See Supplemental Rule 3(b).*
- DEADLINE for Canadian National Division Advisor Registration** – Advisor registration form must be forwarded to the Canadian National Administrator. *See Supplemental Rule 3(c).*

- December 2003** Second Distribution of Basic Materials by ILSA (a second diskette, this time based upon requests from teams for additional treaties, caselaw, and secondary sources).
- December 22, 2003** **FINAL DEADLINE for Non-U.S. Team Registration with ILSA** (Late fees apply after November 24, 2003). Withdrawal from the Competition is not possible after this date. *See Official Schedule.*
- January 15, 2004** Release date for room block (guaranteed Conference room rates) with the Westin Bayshore Resort & Marina. Hotel reservations should be made prior to this date. For more information on hotel accommodations, see Canadian Qualifying Tournament web page at <http://faculty.law.ubc.ca/jessup>.
- January 16, 2004** **DEADLINE for Mailing Memorials and Computer Disks** to the Canadian National Administrator in accordance with provisions of *Supplemental Rule 8(e)* and emailing Memorials to the ILSA Executive Office in accordance with provisions of *Official Rule 8.1*. **Must be postmarked by this date.**
- DEADLINE for Returning Rotating Trophies** - The Ronald St. John MacDonald Award, the Maxwell Cohen Cup, the Gerald Fitzgerald Award, the Donat Pharand Award, the Charles Bourne Award, and the Canadian Spirit of the Jessup Award must be returned to the Canadian National Administrator. *See Supplemental Rule 15(c).*
- February 11-14, 2004** **2004 Canadian National Division Qualifying Tournament** hosted by the University of British Columbia in Vancouver, B.C.
- March 19, 2004** **DEADLINE for School(s) Representing Canada in the 2004 Shearman & Sterling International Rounds** to submit Confirmation Forms to the ILSA Executive Office. *See Official Schedule.*
- March 29-April 3, 2004** **Shearman & Sterling International Rounds**, Washington DC, USA.
- February 9-12, 2005** **2005 Canadian National Division Qualifying Tournament** hosted by the University of Victoria in Victoria, B.C.
